

Arc Flash Update

Meet the New NFPA 70E Standard for Arc Flash Safety and Compliance.

What are the NFPA 70E updates?

The NFPA 70e updates span changes to training, PPE, documentation, labels, and job hazards. NFPA 70E makes changes to the requirements every three years. These changes could result in a change to your arc flash assessment and will result in a change to your safety manual and training. If your facility or job site has had any major changes or upgrades, it's important to understand how the updates affect it.

Who is impacted by the changes?

All companies where employees are working in the vicinity of energized systems and may be exposed to electrical hazards should adopt the new standard and update their safety programs accordingly. It is also recommended that employees receive training every three years in line with the NFPA updates.
